Cango is Hail and Ride

You no longer need to book your journey on Cango. Instead you can just turn up at the designated time and go.

This means that you don't have to plan your journey in advance and can return on any trip you wish.

Cango will now run to a set route and most of the route will be 'hail and ride' so you don't even have to walk to a bus stop.

The bright yellow Cango buses, with two wheelchair spaces and regular drivers, will stay the same.



The blue line marks the route, which **no longer serves Tesco from 1st September**, to improve timekeeping. The service is hail and ride along the route where the bus will stop anywhere that it is safe to do so, **except** within Andover town where the bus will stop at the bus station only.
