

Minutes of the meeting of Barton Stacey Planning Committee held at 18:30 on Monday 4th March 2019 at All Saints Church, Barton Stacey

Meeting opened at 18:30. Present: Cllr Sue Gaines, Cllr Cheryl Sherwood, Cllr Cooper. Also present: The Clerk. Members of the public: 0

3. **Declarations** – to receive and record declarations of interest in items on the agenda -none.

5. **Planning applications**

19/00308/FULLN – extension of number of days permitted as race days from current (28 days) To total of 38 days (a net increase of 10 days) per calendar year at Forest Edge Kart Club, Drayton Road, Barton Stacey, SO21 3BF

This is not a one off application but one for many years to come. The noise assessment is inadequate as they didn't take the wind direction into account and only taken place on one day, which was a practise day. The PC confirmed that no neighbours were informed of the planning application – not even the residents at Drayton Park. Proposed and resolved to object the application due to the following. 1/ inadequate noise assessment. 2/FEKC originally confirmed to the PC that they wanted an increase of between 3-5 days a year but this application is a 10 day increase which is a huge increase and contradicts what they previously had said. 3/ It is not a one off increase it is for future years and the PC feel they should be able to accommodate this within their current 28 days.

19/00404/TREEN – T1 fell, T2,3,4 – pollard to between 12-15m at The Swan Inn, Cocum Road, Barton Stacey

3 Ash and 1 sycamore which are all in need of work located around the boundary of the pub car park. These were identified by the PC tree consultant. They don't have TPOs but are in the Conservation Area thus requiring planning. Proposed and resolved to support the application following advice from our tree consultant.
